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### **Statement:**

The Superintendency recognizes that partnerships and sponsorships enhance learning opportunities for students, increase community support for public education and foster a positive quality of life in communities

- 153.1 The Principal shall be responsible to ensure that all partnerships and sponsorships between schools and community-based organizations, businesses, governments and other educational institutions are in compliance with the **Goals/Principles, Requirements/Standards, and Guidelines/Recommendations outlined in Department of Education Policy 315**.
- 153.2 **A partnership** is a formal arrangement based on a mutually beneficial relationship for all partners. The primary basis of an educational partnership is the exchange of human and/or physical resources to expand opportunities for student learning.  
**Sponsorship** is support offered in the form of an agreement to provide a specific type of assistance to a school, school district or to the public education system as a whole. Sponsorship agreements include an understanding to recognize the sponsor (e.g., in published formats or verbal message).
- 153.3 All partnerships and sponsorships must have a written agreement as outlined in Department of Education Policy 315 and such agreements must be forwarded to the Director of Finance and Administration and are also to be kept at the school for seven (7) years.
- 153.4 All funds must be accounted for in accordance with Anglophone East School District Policy 103.
