POLICY NO: 2.3 - COUNCIL JOB DESCRIPTION

APPROVED: OCTOBER 26, 2005

POLICY: THE ROLE OF THE COUNCIL IS TO REPRESENT THE COMMUNITY OF SCHOOL DISTRICT 2 IN DETERMINING AND DEMANDING APPROPRIATE ORGANIZATIONAL PERFORMANCE. TO DISTINGUISH THE COUNCIL'S OWN UNIQUE WORK FROM THE WORK OF ITS STAFF, THE COUNCIL SHALL CONCENTRATE ON:

- 1.0 Being a link between the organization and the community of School District 2.
- 2.0 Developing governing policies which, at the broadest levels, address:
 - 2.1 Ends: Organizational impacts, benefits, outcomes, recipients, and their relative worth (what good for which people and needs at what cost).
 - 2.2 Council Process: Description of how the council conceives, carries out and monitors its own task.
 - 2.3 Council/Superintendent Linkage: Delegation of power and its proper use monitored; the Superintendent's role, authority and accountability.
 - 2.4 Superintendent Limitations: Constraints on the superintendent's authority which establish the prudence and ethics boundaries within which all Superintendent activity and decisions must take place.
- 3.0 Assuring organizational performance.
- 4.0 Advocating on behalf of School District 2.
