POLICY NO: 2.6 – COUNCIL COMMITTEE PRINCIPLES

APPROVED: OCTOBER 26, 2005
MARCH 23, 2010

POLICY: ADHERING TO THE PRINCIPLES OF POLICY GOVERNANCE, PERMANENT COUNCIL STANDING COMMITTEES SHALL NOT BE FORMED; RATHER THE WORK OF THE COUNCIL SHALL BE PERFORMED BY COUNCIL OF THE WHOLE.

- 1.0 The Chair has the authority to appoint interested Council members and non-council members if their expertise is required to gather information to be presented to the Committee of the Whole for discussion. The Chair would request the Superintendent to designate the appropriate District staff to assist the members in their endeavours. Where possible this information and other pertinent facts will be made available to Council members at least one week before the discussion is to take place.
- 2.0 These interested Council members shall not speak or act for the Council except when formally given such authority for specific and time-limited purposes. Expectations and authority shall be carefully stated in order not to conflict with authority delegated to the Superintendent.
- 3.0 These interested Council members shall not exercise any authority over staff, and shall only exist until the completion of their specific task.
