Policy: Respecting Provincial Targets contained in the Provincial 10 Year Education Plan, the District Education Council shall ensure that students in Anglophone East School District achieve numeracy skills as demonstrated through report card data by strand.

1.0 To this end:

- 1.1 The Council expects 80% of students in kindergarten to grade 8 will achieve at the meeting or excelling levels (3, 3+, 4, 4+) by the end of each school year.

- 1.2 The Council will monitor the following items at the high school level:
number of students taking each math course, percentage of students who complete each course successfully, and the median mark in each course.

Policy 1.1 (cont.)

- 1.3 Students who follow a Personalized Learning Plan-Adjusted Curriculum will be monitored to ensure individual growth. The council expects that 100% of students on Personalized Learning Plans-Adjusted Curriculum in kindergarten to grade eight will meet with success (3, 3+, 4, 4+) based on their individual academic goals by the end of each school year.

Monitoring:

Method: Data Report by the Superintendent

Frequency: Two reports per year

Months: November, April

November

The monitoring report should:

- define the target,
- show where the District is in relation to the target,
- demonstrate how the district will achieve this target.

April

The monitoring report should:

- show the progress of the target outlined in November

November

The monitoring report should:

- show the progress from April to November
- Set a new target and demonstrate how the district will achieve it.
