POLICY NO: 4.5 - COMMUNICATION AND ADVICE TO THE COUNCIL

POLICY: WITH RESPECT TO PROVIDING INFORMATION AND ADVICE TO THE COUNCIL, THE

SUPERINTENDENT SHALL NOT PERMIT THE COUNCIL TO BE UNINFORMED.

## The superintendent shall not:

- 1.0 Neglect to submit monitoring data required by the council (see Policy 3.3 Monitoring Organizational Performance) in a timely, accurate and understandable fashion, directly addressing provisions of the council policies being monitored.
- 2.0 Fail to advise the Council in a timely manner of trends, facts and information relevant to the Council's work.
- 3.0 Fail to advise the Council of significant external and internal changes, particularly changes in the assumptions upon which any council policy has previously been established.
- 4.0 Fail to provide a mechanism for official council, officer or committee communications.

- 5.0 Fail to deal with the Council as a whole except when:
  - 5.1 fulfilling individual requests for information,
  - 5.2 responding to council members or ad-hoc committees duly charged by the council, 5.3 initiating the distribution of information to officers, committees and individual members as appropriate.
  - 6.0 Fail to advise the Chair if, in the Superintendent's opinion, the Council or individual members are not in compliance with the Council's policies on Governance Process and Superintendent Limitations.
  - 7.0 Fail to report in a timely manner an actual or anticipated noncompliance with any policy of the Council.
