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Statement:

The Superintendency recognizes its responsibility to provide safe and orderly schools conducive to both learning and teaching as per Anglophone East School District Code of Conduct.

- 332.1 The Principal shall ensure the establishment of a Student Code of Conduct, reflective of Provincial Policy 703, District Education Council Policy 1.3.
- 332.2 The Principal shall seek input from students, staff, families, and community (PSSC) in the development of this Code.
- 332.3 The Principal shall develop appropriate strategies for communicating this Code to staff, students and parents/guardians.
- 332.4 All staff members are responsible for the consistent application of the Code of Conduct.
- 332.5 The Code is to be reviewed on an annual basis.
