Statement:

The Superintendency recognizes its responsibility to provide safe and orderly schools conducive to both learning and teaching as per Anglophone East School District Code of Conduct.

332.1	The Principal shall ensure the establishment of a Student Code of Conduct, reflective of Provincial Policy 703, District Education Council Policy 1.3.
332.2	The Principal shall seek input from students, staff, families, and community (PSSC) in the development of this Code.
332.3	The Principal shall develop appropriate strategies for communicating this Code to staff, students and parents/guardians.
332.4	All staff members are responsible for the consistent application of the Code of Conduct.
332.5	The Code is to be reviewed on an annual basis.
