Statement:

The Superintendency recognizes its responsibility to provide safe and secure school environments.

- 333.1 Principals shall ensure that adequate supervision is provided for all school activities.

- 333.2 Principals are responsible for reporting all known safety concerns to the Facilities Manager.
- 333.3 Principals shall ensure that fair and appropriate regulations for the safety and protection of all staff and students are established and that all staff, students, parents/guardians, and visitors are aware of their responsibilities within the regulations.

- 333.4 Principals shall notify parents/guardians of the hours playgrounds are under supervision and what hours schools are prepared to receive students.
