

NBTA SUPPLY TEACHER MEMBERS' CATEGORIES

 Casual Members: those teachers who are licensed and have taught their first day. Casual members pay dues of \$2.62/day to NBTA and \$1.29/day to NBTF.

 Associate Members: those teachers who are on a local permit. Members pay a flat fee of \$60.

- Voting rights



Uncharted 2020: When There is No Compass is the NBTXS first virtual early career teacher conference. Uncharted 2020 assistors will be offered virtually between Seytember 2020 and Petharay 2021. Sessions will be a combination of hive and asynchronous. Live seasions will be recorded and made available to members unable to participate during the scheduled time Sessions are designed for the larget audience of tachers in their first five years.

Uncharted 2020: When There is No Compass Virtual Conference Overview: All conference offerings will run between September 2020 and February 2021. The monthly schedule will be made available on the 1st day of each month and will include a detailed description of the session and the name of the facilitator.

Each session is scheduled between 3h30 – 4h15. We are aware that many schools have had to modify school start and end times and this time may need to be re-evaluated. There is no cost to attend any of the sessions within the conference offerings.

Newtrocords easions will be precised on the first day of each month and the previous month's sessions will be removed. Sessions will be housed in the members' only section of the NBTA webite.

Early career teachers can pick and choose the sessions they wish to attend. There is no need to be available for all live offerings in order to register. Initial conference offerings will be hosted on Zoom. NBTA is currently exploring other platforms for interactive sessions and these will be eventually incorporated.
