POLICY: THE DISTRICT EDUCATION COUNCIL SHALL INSURE THAT CONTINUOUS COMMUNICATION AND COMMUNITY LINKAGE PROCESSES ARE UTILIZED IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE CONGRUITY OF PURPOSE, MONITOR THE ACHIEVEMENT OF ENDS, AND REFLECT DISTRICT POLICIES.

- 1.0 Communication shall be established in an atmosphere of mutual trust that is open, respectful, and invitational. Creative, innovative, and proactive thinking shall be encouraged.
- 2.0 Exchange and dialogue shall be conducted in an honest and timely manner, which recognizes the importance of two-way communication.
- 3.0 Council shall maintain communication links between the Council and the Parent School Support Committees with respect to matters relating to the duties of the Parent School Support Committees.
- 4.0 The Council will be receptive to, and initiate communication with internal and external businesses, committees, and organizations in order to reflect community values and vision.

- 5.0 Member interaction with the public, press or other entities must recognize the same limitation and the inability of any Council member to speak for the Council except to repeat explicitly stated Council decisions. The Council Chairperson or designate is the official voice of the Council.
- 6.0 Council Members shall submit Member Updates at regular Business Meetings.
