

Dear Anglophone East School District Families & Community Partners,

Given the unprecedented growth that we are experiencing across our school district and to ensure that we continue to provide quality educational experiences for all students, on March 21<sup>st</sup>, at the public meeting for the Anglophone East School District, District Education Council (DEC), the Council voted to move forward with the <u>Policy 409</u> process. We have included a <u>recording of the meeting here</u>.

Our next step in the process are public consultation engagement sessions. There will be two public engagement sessions, in both sessions we will review all the options; the second session will be a repeat of the first, therefore you will not need to attend both sessions.

If you have ideas or feedback that you would like to share at one of the consultations, <u>please fill out this form</u> prior to Monday, April 10<sup>th</sup>. Our communications department will follow up with the process and your place in the speaking order at the consultation you select to attend. To give opportunity for all to take part it is important that ideas and feedback be limited to a maximum of three minutes.

Following the consultations, the DEC will make a decision regarding the proposed changes at their next public meeting on Thursday, April 27<sup>th</sup>. <u>This meeting will be livestreamed here</u>.
