Other/miscellaneous Frequently Asked Questions about school registration:

What does my child need in order to graduate with a New Brunswick High School Diploma?

- Students are required to fulfill the requirements set by the Department of Education for graduation as set out by Policy 316A [316AA.pdf \(gnb.ca\)](#) and Policy 316B [316AB.pdf \(gnb.ca\)](#).
- If your child has not completed all the required courses necessary to graduate but has reached the age of 19, she or he may apply for permission to stay until the required courses are earned or continue with an Adult High School Diploma to finish the necessary courses [Adult High School Diploma - Certification \(gnb.ca\)](#).

What happens if my child is not here for the first day of school?

- If your child is not going to be at school on the first day, you must notify the school in writing.

Does the Anglophone East School District provide transportation by school bus?

- Students who live more than 2.4 km (1.5 miles) from their neighbourhood school, and 1.5 km down a side road from the closest bus stop location are eligible for bussing. This is according to the ***Education Act, Regulation 2001-51: Pupil Transportation Regulations***.
- Please note that, as per ***District Policy 346***: Enrollment at a School – Out of Boundary (also see Application for Enrollment at a School out of the Geographic Boundary), the parents/guardians of a student granted permission to attend a school outside of their geographic boundary are responsible for the transportation of that student to and from school.
